I further certify that the value of the labor and improvements placed thereon by the applicant or their grantors, is not less than Five Hundred Dollars, and that said improvements consist of Disc. Shaft No. 1, 4x8x150ft. deep, with tunnel 5x6x89ft long, and an Open cut 8x12x17ft long, also connected with this shaft, about 3000 cu. ft. of levels and stopes.
